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A Note for the Caregiver

This book is built to be shared. The puzzles and pictures matter less than the time you spend on them together.

The word searches are large and deliberately gentle. Words run only left to right and top to bottom — never backwards and never on a diagonal. There are twelve words per puzzle, not thirty. If a puzzle is finished in five minutes, that is the point.

There is no order you have to follow. Open to a chapter that looks inviting and start there. Skip anything that does not land. A page left undone is not a page failed.

The conversation starters at the beginning of each chapter are the part people tend to remember afterwards. Read one aloud and then wait. Silence is fine. If a question opens something up, follow it and leave the puzzles for another day.

What Is Inside

Ten chapters

Each one is a piece of ordinary life in the 1960s — the kitchen, the garden, Saturday at the movies.

Six questions

Every chapter opens with six things to talk about. Read them aloud.

Four word searches

Large print, twelve words, one puzzle to a page.

Three pictures to color

Bold, simple outlines with room to work.

One page of sayings

Familiar phrases with the last word missing. Answers at the bottom.
